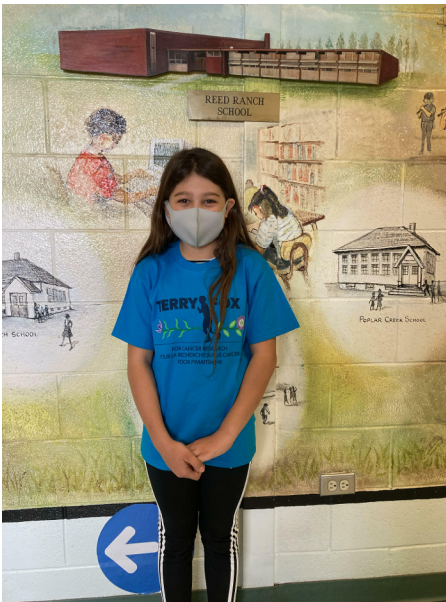

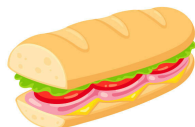

KINDERGARTEN:

MS. CRANSTON'S GRADE 3 & 4 CLASS

Language Arts: We are continuing the year doing our Daily 5 program. The students seem to be enjoying the variety and choice this format offers. Over the next few weeks we will be wrapping up our beginning unit and moving on to our Halloween spooky stories unit where we will be using our new spelling rules and descriptive words to write our first creative story!

Math: We will be finishing the first part of our number systems unit soon with estimation, counting money and adding/subtracting 3 and 4 digit numbers. We will then be moving on to unit 2 where we will be looking at patterns in a variety of formats.

Social Studies: We are looking at the land of Alberta and how it affects our lives. We will also be learning about fossils and fossil fuels.

Science: We are continuing our look at simple machines with a focus on levers, wheels, pulleys and gears! Students will look at how these machines change the amount and direction of forces.

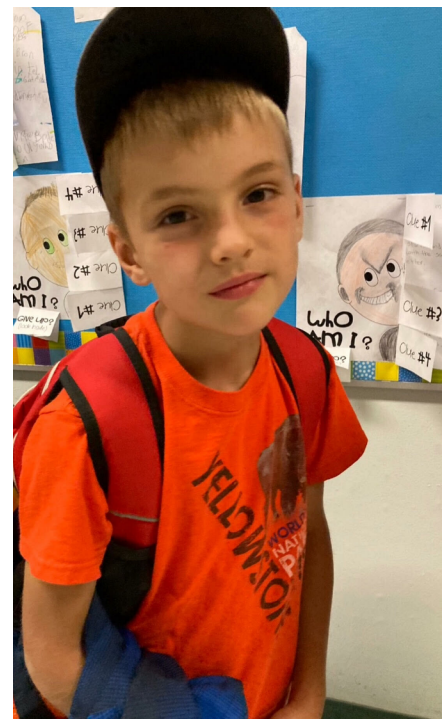
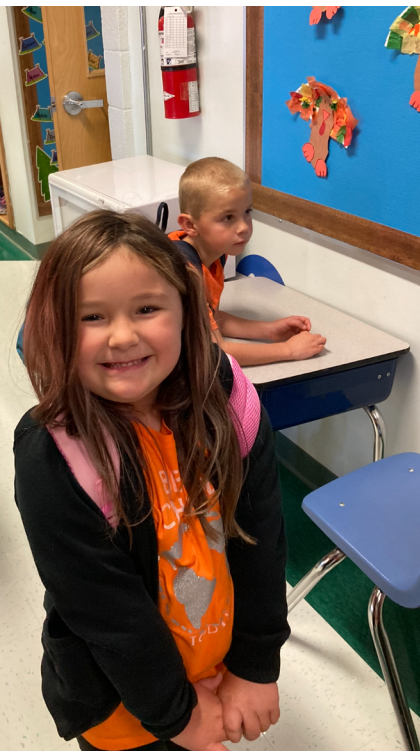
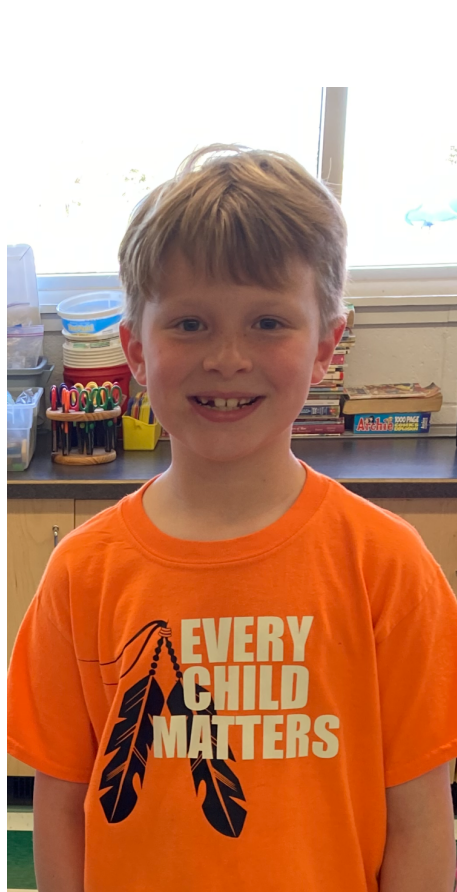
