June 3, 2024 \$5,000- Reed Ranch School Playground

Reed Ranch School Parent Advisory Council sought funding to construct a new playground on the school grounds. Reed Ranch School is a public school within the Chinook's Edge School division, about 17 km east of Olds, and provides learning for kindergarten to grade 6.

Fun times at the zoo...













Well here we are facing our last few weeks of kindergarten!! This school year has really flown by! For the month of June we will be focusing on our new Ocean theme and things related to the Summer.

<u>Literacy</u>: Students will practice blending sounds together to make words, identifying the beginning/middle/end sounds and letters of words, counting syllables in words and counting the number of words in a sentence.

<u>Numeracy:</u> We will be completing our measurement unit (comparing the lengths of objects as well as the volume and weight of objects) and we will start exploring our 3D unit. We will learn about 3-D shapes which include -cones, spheres, cubes, pyramids, cylinders and rectangular prisms.

<u>Science</u> - For the remainder of the school year, we will be exploring our Earth Systems unit. Students will examine and describe surrounding environments.

Little Reminder:

- 1. The last day of <u>Kindergarten</u> will be on <u>Tuesday, June 25, 2024.</u> We finish up a little earlier than students in Grade 1-6.
- 2. Please make sure all library books are returned before the last day of school.

I want to say a big THANK YOU to all my amazing parents and grandparents for all your support this year. You are appreciated more than you will ever know. It has been a great year with my kindergarten class! They have been a true joy to teach and I'm grateful for the opportunity I had to teach them. Please remember to practice reading and writing this summer. Children at this age need continued practice of new skills. Hope you all have a wonderful, relaxing and safe summer!!

Welcome to the Month of June! It is hard to believe it is the last month of school for the year!

Language Arts We are so proud of the progress all of our students have been making with their reading and writing skills this year. Students continue to work on adding more sound -letter combinations to their knowledge bank to help become better readers *and* spellers. <u>Math</u> For the month of June we will be exploring our measurement unit and also continue to work on our understanding of addition/subtraction facts. Grade 1's will continue to learn basic facts to 20, with a focus on partners of tens and doubles, while Grade 2's will continue to strengthen their skills of adding/subtracting numbers 1-100.

<u>Social Studies</u> We will learn various ways of how we can take care of our world.

<u>Science</u> We are learning about Living Systems for the month of June.

We appreciate all that you do to support your child and their learning! Thank you for partnering with us to help your child(ren) be successful this year.

Language Arts: We are looking at creative uses of writing including poetry and reader's theatre to finish off our year.

Math: We are working on our last units of geometry and data collection and graphing. Students will then begin a review unit where we retouch on some of the most important skills we have learned this year such as addition/subtraction, multiplication tables and fractions/decimals.

Social Studies: We are looking at the celebrations and challenges of Alberta.

Science: Our last science unit is living systems. We are looking at food chains, and how plants and animals meet their needs. In collaboration with social studies, we will be focussing mainly on Alberta animals.

This has been a fantastic year in our class! Have a wonderful summer and I look forward to seeing you next year!
